Listed below are the hiring standards for the Rawlins Police Department.

Wyoming Peace Officers Standards Training Exam

All candidates, with the exception of Wyoming Peace Officers, are required to take the Peace Officers Standards Training exam. You need to make arrangements for this exam in Cheyenne, WY. To make arrangements, please call 307-777-6619. There is a \$35 fee for this exam payable at the time you take the test. There are four sections to this test, and each portion must be passed with at least a 70%. You will be tested on basic math, reading comprehension, spelling, grammar, punctuation and writing skills. Those who successfully pass this test will go on to do the physical fitness assessment.

Physical Fitness Requirements

All candidates, with the exception of Wyoming Certified Peace Officers, are required to successfully complete our physical fitness requirements. All areas of this test must be passed in order to continue on. It is important to know that when training for the physical fitness test that Rawlins is at an elevation of 6,744 feet.

Certified In Another State

If you are certified in another state and your credentials are current within the last five years, you can do the challenge process through P.O.S.T. To be eligible for this, you must maintain a current CPR card, complete firearms training along with successful completion of the challenge exam. If you are a successful candidate you will be required to take 40 hours of Criminal Law, and 40 hours of Domestic Law.
